Notice Inviting Tender (NIT)

For Selection of Pharmacies/Supplier for supply of Medicines, Surgical, Consumables and Implants to Public Health Facilities under Atal Amrit Abhiyan (AAA) and Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) in the State of Assam.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. **Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana**, a scheme managed and administered by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India through National Health Authority with the objective of reducing out of pocket healthcare expenses and improving access of validated Beneficiary Family Units to quality inpatient care and day care surgeries for treatment of diseases and medical conditions through a network of Empaneled Health Care Providers.
2. **Atal Amrit Abhiyan**, a scheme managed and administered by the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Assam through Atal Amrit Abhiyan Society with the objective of reducing out of pocket healthcare expenses and improving access of validated Beneficiaries to quality inpatient care and day care surgeries for treatment of diseases and medical conditions such as Cardiology and Cardiovascular Surgeries, Neurological conditions, Burns, Cancer, Kidney diseases, Neo-natal diseases, ICU packages, Trauma, Critical care Pediatrics, Pediatrics Surgery, Japanese Encephalitis and Acute Encephalitic Syndrome and Supplementary Packages, through a network of Empaneled Health Care Providers.
3. **Purpose:** The purpose of this Tender Document is to select the most competent and competitive Agency to supply of Medicines, Surgical, Consumables and Implants to Public Health Facilities under Atal Amrit Abhiyan (AAA) and Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) in the District Hospital, Hatsingimari under South Salmara Mankachar District.
4. The District Hospital Hatsingimari, under the Government of Assam, is looking to adopt a bidding process to select a supplier for medicines, surgical items, consumables, and implants. This procurement is for the Atal Amrit Abhiyan (AAA) and Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) in the State of Assam.
5. **The minimum qualification criteria for the Agency/Supplier:**
 - a. The pharmacy/ chemist shop should be registered under Shops and Establishment Act/ Indian Partnership Act 1932/Companies Act 1956 and should be in existence continuously for at least last three financial years.
 - b. The pharmacy/chemist must be operating retail outlets as per Assam Food and Drug Administration (FDA) norms including Drugs and Cosmetic Act, 1940 and Drug and cosmetic Rules, 1945, Pharmacy Practice Act, 1948 and Pharmacy Practice Regulations, 2015.

- c. The pharmacy/chemist must be operating a 24x7 retail outlet in the near vicinity of the concerned public EHCP. The pharmacy/ chemist shop must have all necessary medicines, consumables and implants regular supply and adequate stock. The pharmacy/chemist should supply medicines and other items at minimum 20% reduced rate.
- d. Average annual turnover of last three years of the bidder should be minimum Rs 20 lakhs.
- e. The pharmacy/chemist must have valid drug license and must not have been convicted by the State drugs authorities and no case should be pending under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Rules against him/her(Non conviction certificate to be enclosed).
- f. The bidder should have Goods and Services Tax Identification Number (GSTIN) and should be regularly paying his/her GST.
- g. The bidder should not be currently debarred by any Government organization.

6. Preparation of tender:

The interested bidders should submit duly signed and stamped Technical and Financial bids in chronological order with hard copies of all relevant certificates, documents etc, to the O/o Joint DHS, South Salmara Mankachar District with Name and Address of Bidder before the closing time, containing the following documents.

- A. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.49,999.00 in the form of Demand Draft/ Pay Order from scheduled banks in favor of Hospital Management Society(Account No: 33985691479, IFSC Code: SBIN0009440, Branch: Hallydayganj).
- B. Undertakings & Affidavits in Non-judicial stamp paper.

7. Validity of Tender:

In this context, the validity of the tender is initially for 12 months. This means that the terms and conditions of the tender, including the pricing and other details, will be applicable for a period of 12 months from the date of acceptance or award of the tender.

If the performance of the selected bidder is satisfactory during this initial period, the undersigned (presumably the procuring authority) may choose to extend the bidder's service beyond the initial 12 months. This extension would be based on mutual agreement and subject to the terms and conditions outlined in the tender documents.

8. Validity of Bids:

In this case, the bidder is required to submit the bid within 21 days from the date of publication. This means that the bid must be submitted and received by the specified authority within this timeframe to be considered valid. It's important for bidders to carefully note and adhere to this deadline to ensure that their bids are considered for evaluation.
